

Year 3 – Curriculum Information

Literacy

Literature Works Text – The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe

Narrative – Classic Fiction/Adventure

- Explore different elements to story writing – describing characters and settings, problems and solutions.
- Write character and setting descriptions.
- Write own adventure story based on elements of class text.
- Other writing opportunities linked to Literature Works text – character descriptions, grammar and punctuation work.
- Comprehension activities based on Literature Works text including hot seating, conscious alley, predictions, etc.

Numeracy

- Count in multiples of 0, 4, 8 50 and 100.
- Reinforce multiplication and division facts of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.
- Use mental and formal written methods to multiple and divide numbers (multiplication grid and long division).
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division, using methods above.
- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.
- Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

Topic – My Money

- Reflect on what we spend our money on. Discuss what is essential and what is not.
- Discuss life before currency. Explore process of bartering and explore problems associated.
- Explore notes and coins. Children to design own bank note.
- Explore income and expenditure – children to budget and work out if they can afford different things.
- Discuss saving – bank accounts.
- Explore advantages and disadvantages of borrowing money. Work out interest.
- Debate the implications of financial headlines
- Explore fund raising for a charity.

I.C.T – Data

- Understand the difference between data and information. Identify what data should be collected to answer a specific question.
- Create frequency diagrams and graphs to answer questions.
- Use a prepared spreadsheet to record data.
- Use a prepared spreadsheet to explore simple number patterns.

P.S.H.C.E – SEAL – Relationships

- Explore how to make people who are important to us happy.
- Express feelings of guilt and explain ways to make amends.
- Learn to take responsibility for actions and also tell someone if they have hurt their feelings.

RE – Hinduism: God and Worship in the Home

- Learn about aspects of Hindu beliefs.
- Learn about Hindu worship.
- Learn about Hindu gods and goddesses.
