


## English Knowledge Organiser- Narrative - Year 3 Block 1

| KEY                | VOCABULARY  |
|--------------------|---|
| Proper noun        | A noun, which refers to a particular person, place or organisation. They start with a capital letter.         |
| Common noun        | A noun, which does not refer to a particular person, place or organisation. They do not start with a capital. |
| Concept            | An abstract idea.   |
| The power of three | Three words used in conjunction to create a meaningful impact.  |
| Fronted adverbial  | An adverb or adverbial phrase, which come at the beginning of sentence.                                       |
| Dictionary         | A reference book, which provides information relating to words, including spellings.                          |
| Thesaurus          | A reference book, which provides synonyms and antonyms.   |
| Antonym            | A word with the opposite meaning to another.  |

## Learning Intention

In this block, children will explore the narrative structure in greater depth. During this unit time, rather than a journey, will be the principal theme. The book 'Stone Age Boy' will be the narrative children will use to develop their literacy skills. Children will explore tense and incorporate the power of three to develop their writing repertoire.
