## Key Vocabulary

<b>Pamina</b>	The Magic Flute character A brave and fearless princess
<b>Tamino</b>	The Magic Flute character A heroic and lovesick prince
<b>Papageno</b>	The Magic Flute character A funny bird catcher
<b>Opera</b>	A dramatic performance, set to music for singers and instrumentalists
<b>Conductor</b>	A person who directs the performance of an orchestra or choir. The conductor keeps the beat
<b>Orchestra</b>	A group of instrumentalists, usually combining string, woodwind, brass, and percussion sections
<b>Melody</b>	A sequence of notes that is the main tune of a song
<b>Polyphonic</b>	When two or more voices are singing at the same time, each with an independent melody

## The Magic Flute

*The Magic Flute* is a fairy tale of darkness, light, and finding your way in the world. It was written by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and premiered on the 30<sup>th</sup> September 1791, just two months before Mozart died. It was an instant hit in Vienna and soon took the whole of Europe by storm. Today, it remains the third most frequently performed opera in the world.
