LITERACY

Review written calculation methods - column multiplication, column subtraction

Use written calculation methods to divide - Long division

Reinforce multiplication facts of the 7,8,9, 12 times tables- Weekly times table tests

Solve problems involving calculation methods

Time - Read the time on the analogue and digital clock - 24 hours

To convert times from digital to analogue - knowing how many minutes to the hour.

To read timetables and calculate the length of time for a journey.

Learn about different types of triangles, polygons and symmetry

Programming- learning new commands to program the BBC Microbit

Use Data Logger to collect information in Science

Use the internet to support learning in numeracy and science

LIVING AND GROWING- PLANTS

Helping plants grow well - Learn about plant growth, set up experiments to establish what plants need to be healthy. Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers. Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
