Key Vocabulary

capital city - a **town** or **city** where the government meet.



city - a place where people live and work which is larger than a **town**.



continent - a very large area of land made up of lots of **countries** including islands.



country - an area of land with its own government, rules and borders.

culture - many **different** things make up a society's **culture**, including: food, clothing, tools, music, arts, beliefs and religion.

different - not alike in character or quality.

landmark - a feature of a landscape or place that is easily recognised.



Countries and Capital Cities of the United Kingdom

England

England is the largest **country** in the **UK**. London is the **capital city**.

Wales

Yr Wyddfa (Mount Snowdon) is the tallest mountain in Wales. Cardiff is the **capital city**.



Scotland

Ben Nevis is the highest mountain in the **UK**. Edinburgh is the **capital city**.



Northern Ireland

Northern Ireland is the smallest **country** in the **UK**. Belfast is the **capital city**.
