Recount

- Focus upon features of recounts.
- Write recounts in character based around events in class text.

Poetry - Descriptive

- Focus upon features of poems including description, alliteration, personification, etc.
- Write own descriptive poems based around class text.

Numeracy

- Reinforce multiplication and division facts for 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

- Measure, compare, add and subtract lengths/capacity and mass.

- Identify right angles; identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle.
- Identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines.
