Year 1 Curriculum Information

Literacy

Reinforce and apply word level skills through shared and group reading.

Use phonic build-up of words for reading and writing.

Identify the main events of a story and act in drama.

Be able to put a story into the correct order.

Be able to make simple story plans using pictures.

To write simple stories, starting to use capital letters, full stops and spaces between words.

Be able to write simple captions and lists.

Familiarise the children with the school handwriting style.

Numeracy

Count at least 20 objects, moving up to 30.

Say if a number is 1 more or 1 less than any given number.

Recall all pairs of numbers with a total of 10.

Learn the names of common 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Use objects, pictures or a simple table to organise information.

Put objects in order depending on weight or length.

Use mathematical vocabulary and discuss how they solved a particular problem or puzzle.
