Year One

Literacy

Our Focus text for this half term is "Hairy Maclary from Donaldson's dairy" by Lynley Dodd

- To be able to sequence the story correctly, making our own story plans.
- To read the story and find rhyming words and add our own words.
- To be able to identify different breeds of dogs in the text and complete nonfiction work.
- To write their own stories using a clear beginning, middle and end.
- To continue with our weekly guided reading lessons, focussing on higher order reading skills.
- To continue comprehension work and dictated sentences for preparation for year 2!
- It will also be the Phonics screening test so all extra reading will be of great benefit!

Numeracy

- Bridge through 20 when adding a single digit number.
- Count in multiples of 2, 3, 5 and 10 and apply to simple problems.
- Solve practical problems that involve combining groups of 2, 5 or 10, or sharing into equal groups
- Recall the doubles and halves of all numbers to at least 10
- Read o'clock and half past times on an analogue clock
- Apply mental strategies to solve money and time problems.
- Handle data to solve a problem by organising information in a list or table.
- Explain and verbalise processes in numeracy, including 2 step problems.

Topic – Minibeasts

- This is a Science based topic and will involve the children completing outdoor practical activities.
- We shall investigate minibeasts and their habitats within our school grounds.
- We will look at the characteristics of minibeasts and complete sorting activities related to observable features.
- We will be looking at the different parts of an insect
- We will be looking at lifecycles and looking at caterpillars to butterflies in particular they are in our class now!

I.C.T.

- To revise E-Safety and the correct and safe use of equipment in school.
- To enter data into a database and make simple bar graphs.

P.H.S.C.E.

- Children will identify rules for, and ways of, keeping safe, including basic road safety, and about people who can help them to stay safe.
