

## Year 3 – Curriculum Information

### Literacy – Class Text – The Iron Man

#### Science Fiction

- Explore character of Iron Man, use of adjectives, similes.
- Explore character's thought and feelings/events of story through drama.
- Explore structure of science fiction stories through Iron Man text – beginning, middle and end.
- Plan own science fiction story and use plan to write story.

Spelling, grammar and punctuation work relating to The Iron Man text.

#### Numeracy

- Identify equivalent fractions.
- Solve problems involving fractions.
- Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using formal written methods.
- Tell the time on an analogue and digital clock to the nearest minute.
- Solve time problems.
- Recognise and describe 2D and 3D shapes.
- Draw and make 2D and 3D shapes.
- Identify angles, including right angles, acute angles and obtuse angles.
- Describe shapes, making references to angles.

### Topic – History – The Romans

- Learn about the Roman Invasion.
- Find out about the Roman army – label Roman soldier, focus upon armour, weapons.
- Make Roman shields and swords.
- Design and make catapult.
- Trip to Segedunum.
- Find out about Roman entertainment including theatres, baths, gladiators, chariot racing.
- Learn about influences of the Roman Empire.
- Identify local Roman landmarks.

#### I.C.T – Presentation

- Research information relating to Roman Gods and present using Powerpoint.
- Use layout and design features.
- Locate images from the internet for presentation.
- Select, copy, paste, crop images to suit purpose.
- Evaluate design and layout of presentation.

### P.S.H.C.E – SEAL – Getting on and Falling Out

- Explore skills of friendship – look and sound friendly, be a good listener, take turns, give and receive compliments, see things from someone else's point of view.
- Explore feeling of anger – what triggers are, how our bodies change when we start to get angry, ways to calm down.
- Explore ways to make up – peaceful problem solving to sort out difficulties and solutions.
